Community Member Role Description

Engaging community leaders along with healthcare professionals and educators, assuring a voice for the community-at-large.

The CAPP Community Advisory Board member will:

- Maintain a clear understating of the services provided by the health care center, and ideally be a recipient of these services.
- Act as an advocate for the interests of the community (beneficiaries of health services).
 - Provide a needed perspective on prevalent community health concerns to the CAPP Advisory Board.
 - Maintain contact with various community representatives and other local stakeholders.
 - Report to the Advisory Board any gaps in services as perceived by community members.
 - Serve as the champion of causes that best relate to the interests of their community while campaigning for the improvement of quality of life and health outcomes.
 - Provide input about potential strategies for improving health services.
- Participate constructively and effectively as a community board member for the CAPP Advisory Board in accordance with the role description.
 - Attend quarterly CAPP Advisory Board Meeting.
 - Understand the different roles of CAPP Advisory Board chair, board members, Academic Faculty, Site Coordinators, and the health care staff of the health care center.
 - Understand CAPP Advisory Board processes that determine how the board meetings are run and how decisions are made.
 - Ensure familiarity with agendas and other CAPP Advisory Board reports before meetings.
- Identify and declare any potential personal conflicts of interest, whether these are pecuniary or non-pecuniary.
